REPORT ON HEPATITIS-B AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

Niruja Health club members decided to conduct awareness campaign on Hepatitis-B to the people of Ravalkole village Medchal. Dr. David Convener of the club along with his team briefed the student volunteers about the Hepatitis-B. He said that Hepatitis means inflammation of the liver. When the liver is inflamed or damaged, its function can be affected. Heavy alcohol use, toxins, some medications, and certain medical conditions can all cause hepatitis. However, hepatitis is often caused by a virus. Hepatitis B is a liver infection caused by the hepatitis B virus. Hepatitis B can range from a mild illness lasting a few weeks to a serious, lifelong illness. It spreads when blood, semen, or other body fluid infected with the hepatitis B virus enters the body of a person who is not infected. The best way to prevent hepatitis B is by getting vaccinated. The hepatitis B vaccine is safe and effective. Completing the series of shots is needed for full protection. From here students decided to conduct awareness campaign in "Ravalkole Village" and thereby creating awareness among rural people regarding and causes and consequences of Hepatitis-B. At first they took permission from Gram panchayatand then asked if any villager got affected with Hepatitis. But panchayat doesn't have the exact information. So, student volunteers went house to house and explained about the Hepatitis-B and its symptoms. Students along with villagers felt very happy about the campaign.

The inaugural speech is given by Dr.V.A.Narayana, Principal CMRCET. Later Dr. David, Convener Niruja health club enlightened all the members present on Depression and Anxiety. He said that, Depression and anxiety can occur at the same time. In fact, it's been estimated that 45 percent of people with one mental health condition meet the criteria for two or more disorders. Some symptoms of depression and anxiety overlap, such as problems with sleep, irritability, and difficulty concentrating.

Physical symptoms of depression include:

- · decreased energy, chronic fatigue, or feeling sluggish frequently
- · difficulty concentrating, making decisions, or recalling
- · changes in appetite or weight
- · difficulty sleeping, waking early, or oversleeping

Emotional symptoms of depression include:

- · loss of interest or no longer finding pleasure in activities or hobbies
- persistent feelings of sadness, anxiety, or emptiness
- · feeling hopeless or pessimistic
- · anger, irritability, or restlessness
- feeling guilty or experiencing feelings of worthlessness or helplessness
- suicide attempts

Physical symptoms of Anxiety include:

- feeling fatigued easily
- · difficulty concentrating or recalling
- · muscle tension and racing heart
- · grinding teeth
- · sleep difficulties, including problems falling asleep and restless, unsatisfying sleep

Emotional symptoms of anxiety include:

· restlessness, irritability, or feeling on edge and difficulty controlling worry or fear

How to over-come it:yoga, meditation, breathing exercises, massage and most importantly reach out to someone you're comfortable talking to and talk about whatever you feel like.

REPORT ON AWARENESS PROGRAM ON BREAST CANCER & PERSONAL MENSTRUAL HYGIENE AND SELF-ESTEEM FOR GIRL STUDENTS AND LADY FACULTY

An awareness program on breast cancer, personal menstrual hygiene and self-esteem was conducted by SIDDAM (NGO) organised by NIRUJA (HEALTH) CLUB at CMR College of Engineering & Technology on 13th November 2019. All the girl students and lady faculty attended the program.

The inaugural speech was given by Mrs. Alka Agarwal president, Siddham NGO, DR. Sai Lakshmi Dayaana, a Gynaecologist working at Apollo Hospitals, Jubilee Hills, who works with the NGO helped the girl students to understand the issues related to Breast cancer first and then she continued her session on awareness related to Menstrual Hygiene & Self-esteem. Then she flushed out the myth of menstrual periods being a curse. Women should accept it as a blessing since they are the only one's capable of giving birth. Periods are cleaning of uterus similar to how we brush our teeth, excrete, bath daily to keep ourselves clean. She mentioned the difference between the ovaries and uterus' functioning and their relation to period pain. Later she said about the consumption of pain killers(Dolo-650 & Meftal Spas-500mg thrice a day) do not cause any harm neither does it interfere with fertility pattern or production of hormones. Stress was laid on how heavy periods can make a person anaemic leading to breathlessness, walking drowsily, less supply of oxygen, drop in the haemoglobin levels. The latter can be retained by consuming food rich in iron and coloured vegetables (most likely raw). Alongside, measures were told to keep the earth a more sustainable planet by using biodegradable or cloth napkins rather than the bleached ones. Lastly, the very common problem of polycystic ovaries -the cause, symptoms and preventions were narrated that is said to be caused when ovaries release water bubbles instead of an egg resulting in lesser secretions of female hormones. She stated that "Menstrual periods are global issue" and these periods and pregnancy are interrelated to each other, if periods doesn't happen then there is no chance of pregnancy in women .She even explained the processes of menstruation .She explained that suffering unnecessarily during periods means our hormones are not working properly. In USA the period cramps are less experienced by the women compared to India.

The girl students and lady faculty were obliged for DR. Sai Lakshmi Dayaana efforts to come up and hold an eye-opening seminar on the much needed topic. The entire two hour talk would surely result

in the improvement of a women's self-esteem. Every one thanked Mrs. Alka Agarwal president, Siddham NGO and Niruja Health Club for conducting such a good awareness program





OUTCOME:

After conducting the event students, lady faculty both teaching and non-teaching understood the importance of Personal Hygiene especially during Menstrual time. The session helped them to realise the myths and facts about the periods

REPORT ON AWARENESS PROGRAM ON ADOLESCENCE TO ADULTHOOD FOR BOY STUDENTS AND GENT FACULTY

As part of its efforts to educate its students and thereby prepare them for the challenges that adolescence and later stages of life brings, NIRUJA HEALTH CLUB of CMR College of Engineering & Technology organized awareness and interactive session for boy students and gent faculty at CMRGI Central Auditorium on 13th November 2019. This program was conducted in association with SIDDHAM NGO. The inaugural speech was given by Major. Dr. V.A.Narayana, Principal CMRCET. Then Mrs. Alka Agarwal president, Siddham NGO took over the mike and shared her valuable ideas.

The guest of the day Dr. Ashish Chauhan, MD started his session titled "Awareness Program on Adolescence to Adulthood" for the male students and gent faculty. Dr. Ashish Chauhan began his talk by drawing the students' attention to the fact the topic of sex is a taboo in India. As a result it does not figure in every day public discourse in India. This prevents people from acquiring sufficient knowledge about it as people are discouraged to talk about the same. The absence of knowledge about sex heightens the risks the latter might lead to. Thus, according to Dr Ashish, there is a strong case for open communication about sex among the adolescents and other teenagers. In other words sex education is necessary for all the adolescents. Thus one should acknowledge the fact that having sexual feelings or thoughts is normal. It is by acknowledging the "normalcy" of the sexual feelings that one is in better position to deal with them. What is abnormal is the effort to hide the fact of sex which is the foundation of procreation. The first step towards acknowledgement of reality of sex consists in an awareness of differences in men and women's bodies. He explained how knowledge of human bodies would help to understand the nature of sexuality. The physical changes such as voice change and growth of other organs are a natural part of human development. But they also bring changes one's psychological framework as well.

According to Dr Ashish, our knowledge of sexuality shapes our attitudes towards sexuality and sex. In the absence of an open and frank awareness and knowledge about sex, the youth are exploring sexuality through recourse to online pornographic videos and websites. This is extremely harmful to the fabric of our society. Thus there is strong case for inculcating a right knowledge among the youth through sex education. At the same time we as a society should work towards removal of mystery about women's bodies by discussing how women are as similar as men in many ways. This is all the more necessary since the ancient compendium of knowledge about sex and sexuality, "Kamasutra," was written by an Indian. The education of the youth in sex helps to remove stigma and taboos associated with sex.

The second part of the session was a question and answer session in which Dr.Ashish clarified doubts raised by the students. He explained how sexually transmitted diseases spread and how one can take precautions to stop these diseases. He stressed the need for responsible conduct by everyone. He also spoke about how adolescents can overcome stress and deal with it through a combination of recreation, exercises and social service. Such participation would free oneself from

preoccupation with oneself and would allow them to experience the world in a better way. The program came to an end with a vote of thanks by the Principal.





OUTCOME: After conducting the event boy students, gent faculty both teaching and non-teaching understood the importance of Adolescence to Adulthood. . Such interaction helps t to overcome the difficulties which otherwise might look too difficult to handle.

BENEFICIARIES: Four hundred boy students and forty five gent faculties gained a lot of knowledge from the interactive session. Such participation would free oneself from preoccupation with oneself and would allow them to experience the world in a better way




