National Service Scheme (NSS) Logo

The first education commission recommended the introduction of national services in 1950 by students on a volunteer basis. After all the recommendations finally in 1969, September 24th was declared as NSS Day and birth centenary year of Mahatma Gandhi, the father of nation to whom social service was almost a religion. The scheme now extended to all the States and Universities in the country. Students, teachers, parents, guardians, persons in

authority in the government, realize the need and significance of NSS. The motto of the NSS is “**NOT ME BUT YOU**”. This word is the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for selfless service and appreciation of others. The symbol of the NSS is designed based on ‘Rath wheel’ of Konark, the Sun Temple of Orissa. The wheel signifies the progressive cycle of life. The symbol of NSS Badge contains 24 wheels in the Rath of the Sun Temple of Konark. Each Wheel has eight bars which represents 8 pahars of day. The red colour in the badge indicates that the NSS volunteers are full of blood, i.e. lively, active and spirited. The navy blue color indicates the cosmos of which the NSS is a tiny part ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind.

OBJECTIVES:

- The main objective of the NSS is to instill the idea of social welfare in students and provide community services without bias.
- Every volunteer works to ensure that who is the actual needy to get help for their living which promotes living standards.
- Student personality traits will be improve through community services.
- NSS volunteers should work by mingling with the community agents who represent the people.
- To find inherent talent in his/her knowledge through community services.
- To develop creative and constructive social work action.
- To promote or to serve in the weaker section of community.

Roles / Responsibilities:

- Students should enroll their name as an NSS volunteer in the college and enrollment is limited to 100 members in every academic year.
- Requires active participation in all the activities and to work with/among people.
- Proper dress coding with NSS badges during off the campus or on the campus is mandatory.
- Identify needs, problems and resources of the community along with program officer or local leaders.
- To establish rapport with the people in the project area for community developments.

- Every volunteer should complete 100 hours of work and keep day-to-day record in work activities/experience in work diary and submit to the group leader/program officer for periodic guidance.
- All volunteers should work under the guidance of a group leader nominated by the program officer.
- They shall make themselves worthy of the confidence and cooperation of the group/community leadership.
- They should scrupulously avoid entering into any controversial issues.

Report on Community Visit:

The rural visit, which was organized by our NSS unit provided an opportunity to the students to gain practical skills and be exposed to the rural areas. The students of CMRCET required to go for a study on the impacts of various factors in an unorganized retail sector in the village. Our NSS volunteers and students visited Puduru, Rajbollaram villages; the objective of the study was to know about the problems faced by them and help them in possible way with technology support. The rural camp was held on 15-07-2016. The students were divided into several groups and asked to visit schools, hospital, Gram Panchayat Office etc. This camp went on well and became a grand success.

Community Visit program actively connects grassroots community building efforts in towns across Vermont with state-wide resources, expertise and opportunities. Each Visit brings together a broad mix of community members with a visiting resource team, made up of Council members and statewide providers (state, federal, non-profit, and philanthropic), to create intensive partnerships and tailored work plans for long-term local success. The Visit process is designed for community members to prioritize and choose strategic goals and vision for their community and for the state-wide visiting resource team to provide advice and expertise to help them get there. The program takes place over four months with a series of public meetings, facilitated discussions and community events. To be successful, a broad spectrum of community members must be involved; invitations sent through schools, businesses, and through town offices to residents are very important.

Many people aren't sure how to take charge of this process, letting chance factors such as a convenient job offer from a friend determine the focus of their career. As a result, the majority of workers are less satisfied with their employment. Surveys indicate that two-thirds of all employees are unhappy with their jobs.
