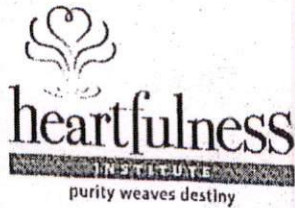

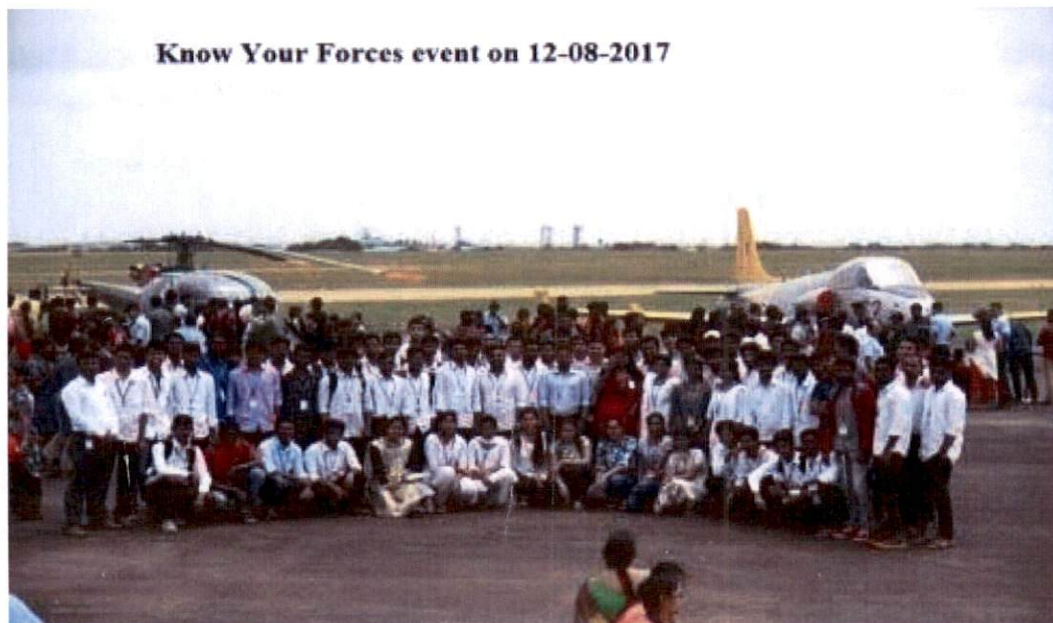

Report on Know Your Force:
