

During the time of freedom women leaders actively pursued the cause of women even as they are fighting the foreign rule. The struggle for equal representation of women in legislatures and other public institutions continued in the post independence era.

Essay writing competition: Women Entrepreneurs

Forms of Violence against women

Violence against women and children is a serious public health concern with vast social levels of society. Although violence is a threat to everyone, women and children are particularly susceptible to victimization because they often have fewer rights or have appropriate means of protection in case of any legal violation, thereby contributing further to the risk to women and children.

In past decade research has documented the growing magnitude of sex violence, but past in the data still remain victims of violence of any age from sexualization of sexual harassment and child abuse. Because it is often hidden, the issue is compounded by the fact that for women & children the fact that issue is compounded by the perpetrator use often people they know & provide with ACS.

Aboriginal women and girls are being and brutalized. Unfortunately they often face life-threatening gender-based violence and disproportionately experience violent crimes because of cultural and racism. According to Statistics Canada, Aboriginal women are three to five times more likely to experience violence than non-Aboriginal women. Unfortunately, this frightening trend has been tracked and information such as the violence in remote communities and non-urgent media coverage have been limited to a small number of violent events. It is important to best express the violence against Aboriginal women that occurs before.

The non-urgent media coverage focuses both on interventions for men and interventions for women. The men are educated on the influences and impacts of violence against women in addition to fostering a change in attitudes and beliefs.

The Essay Writing competition was conducted by WEC-MUDITA, CMRCET with an **aim** to make the students aware of the entrepreneurship advantages. Thirty students participated in the event and two students were announced as the winners. v.kreethi from III ECE and B.Saroja from MBA were the winners.
