Essay writing competition: Women Entrepreneurship

Days of violence against women and children is a serious public health concern with vast social and health impacts. Society through violence is a threat to women and children are particularly susceptible to victimization because they often have fewer rights or have appropriate means of protection. In some societies, it is legally acceptable thereby contributing further to the risk to women and children.

In past decade research has documented the growing magnitude of this problem but past 10-15 years still remain victims of sexual harassment and child abuse. Research in violence against women is complicated by the fact that for women & children the fact that issue is compounded by the perpetrator are often people they know & because violence

Aboriginal women and girls are strong and beautiful. Unfortunately, they often face life-threatening gender-based violence and disproportionately experience violence because of cultural and racism. According to Statistics Canada, Aboriginal women are three to five times more likely to experience violence than non-Aboriginal women. Unfortunately, this disturbing trend has been amplified and exacerbated such as the Clatsop Injustice Social Movement and Kamehameha Women Campaign have been required to assist in eliminating these violent events. It is important to first explore the violence against Aboriginal women and women before.

The Kamehameha campaign focuses both on interventions for men and interventions for women. The men are educated on the experiences and impacts of violence against women in addition to fostering a change in attitudes and beliefs.

The Essay Writing competition was conducted by WEC-MUDITA, CMRCET with an **aim** to make the students aware of the entrepreneurship advantages. Thirty students participated in the event and two students were announced as the winners. v.kreethi from III ECE and B.Saroja from MBA were the winners.


