

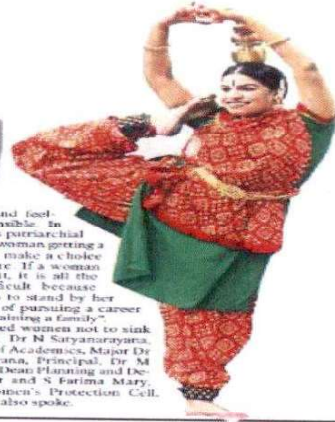
The women's forum of the University of Hyderabad celebrated International Women's Day. All women employees of the University attended in the celebrations in large numbers.
