CMR College of Engineering & Technology (CMR CET) launched Centre for Innovation and Entrepreneurship (CIE) to initiate the Ideas of Students into Business outcome with an objective to Foster and encourage Entrepreneurship; Commercialize technologies based innovations & develop eco-system for a sustainable and holistic growth. As part of CIE, many events have been conducted till date in CMRCET according to the MIC Calendar. So far, three (3) Ideation Days have been conducted in which the students presented more than 200 Ideas from different domains which include Computer Technology, Health & Medical, Agriculture, Mobile Security, Teaching Aids, Transportation & Shipment, Food and Supply Management, Defense, Robotics, IOT etc and Five (5) ideas have been accepted for incubation start ups.

On Tuesday, 19th March 2019, at 11:30 AM, Shri Ajit Doval, National Security Advisor, Govt of India gave a talk on the Art of Decision Making which was aired live on various websites.

1. Followed IIC timeline:

The Institutions Innovation Council (IIC) timeline was perfectly followed as per schedule at the 350 capacitor CMRCET Auditorium on 19th March 2019 at 11:30 AM. All the required arrangements were made prior to the event and all the students and faculty were seated in the auditorium fifteen (15) minutes prior to the event to avoid any last minute hassles. They did a wonderful job by making the students seated in the auditorium by 11:15 AM and by monitoring them. They added value by briefing the main contents of the talk in their free time to the students who were unable to attend.

- ✓ One should have the confidence to deal with the consequences, come what may.
- ✓ Out of the hundreds of decisions that we make in our daily life, we should be wise in taking decisions particularly if the consequences will affect a large number of people for a long period of time.

- ✓ Tough decisions are taken by first having clarity of objectives.
- ✓ Our objectives should be as small and as simple as possible and well defined.
- ✓ We must do an objective analysis of our strengths, circumstances, limitations, resources available and possibilities.
- ✓ We should never take a decision when we are angry or afraid because our objectivity suffers. Decisions are better taken in a calm and composed state of mind. Tough decisions do not leave us with many options because each option has its own consequences. We should take decisions which are feasible for us and give our best on the decisions taken.
- ✓ It is important to take right decisions but making the decisions right is even more important.
- ✓ We should do everything with the spirit of a new child.
- ✓ We must validate our assumptions and consider every day as the first day of our life.
- ✓ We should be fast to hit and quit and we should avoid procrastination at any cost.
- ✓ Circumstances decide whether the decisions made by us are right or wrong.
- ✓ What we should do is our duty; what we want to do is a pleasure. Whenever there is a conflict, always opt for the second one i.e. to do things which are pleasurable to us.
- ✓ The younger generation has a lot of belief and faith in themselves. The government trusts in the Knowledge, vision, commitment and the interest of the younger generation.
