Introduction to NSS Committee:



National Service Scheme (NSS) Logo

The first education commission recommended the introduction of national services in 1950 by students on a volunteer basis. After all the recommendations finally in 1969, September 24th was declared as NSS Day and birth centenary year of Mahatma Gandhi, the father of nation to whom social service was almost a religion. The scheme now extended to all the States and Universities in the country. Students, teachers, parents, guardians, persons in

authority in the government, realize the need and significance of NSS. The motto of the NSS is “**NOT ME BUT YOU**”. This word is the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for selfless service and appreciation of others. The symbol of the NSS is designed based on ‘Rath wheel’ of Konark, the Sun Temple of Orissa. The wheel signifies the progressive cycle of life. The symbol of NSS Badge contains 24 wheels in the Rath of the Sun Temple of Konark. Each Wheel has eight bars which represents 8 pahars of day. The red colour in the badge indicates that the NSS volunteers are full of blood, i.e. lively, active and spirited. The navy blue color indicates the cosmos of which the NSS is a tiny part ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind.

OBJECTIVES:

- The main objective of the NSS is to instill the idea of social welfare in students and provide community services without bias.
- Every volunteer works to ensure that who is the actual needy to get help for their living which promotes living standards.
- Student personality traits will be improve through community services.
- NSS volunteers should work by mingling with the community agents who represent the people.
- To find inherent talent in his/her knowledge through community services.
- To develop creative and constructive social work action.
- To promote or to serve in the weaker section of community.

Roles / Responsibilities:

- Students should enroll their name as an NSS volunteer in the college and enrollment is limited to 100 members in every academic year.
- Requires active participation in all the activities and to work with/among people.
- Proper dress coding with NSS badges during off the campus or on the campus is mandatory.
- Identify needs, problems and resources of the community along with program officer or local leaders.
- To establish rapport with the people in the project area for community developments.

- Every volunteer should complete 100 hours of work and keep day-to-day record in work activities/experience in work diary and submit to the group leader/program officer for periodic guidance.
- All volunteers should work under the guidance of a group leader nominated by the program officer.
- They shall make themselves worthy of the confidence and cooperation of the group/community leadership.
- They should scrupulously avoid entering into any controversial issues.





Report on Haritha Haram Program:

CMR College of Engineering & Technology has organized Haritha Haram program in our campus with NSS and NCC volunteers and it is a large-scale tree-planting program implemented by the Government of Telangana state to increase the amount of tree cover in the state from 24% to 33%.

The program was launched by Telangana Chief Minister Kalvakuntla Chandrasekhar Rao on 3 July 2015. It is one of the most prestigious programs in Telangana Flagship programs to rejuvenate degraded forests, protecting these forests from threats such as smuggling, encroachment, fire and grazing. It adopted intensive soil and moisture conservation measures based on a watershed approach

In the areas outside the existing forest, massive planting activities were to be taken up in areas such as; road-side avenues, river and canal banks, barren hills, tank bunds and foreshore areas, institutional premises, religious places, housing colonies, community lands, municipalities and industrial parks. The National Forest Policy of India envisages a minimum of 33% of the total geographical area under forest cover to maintain environmental stability and ecological balance, which is vital for the sustenance of all life-forms, be it human, animal or plant.
