
#### Lab Activities and Events:





#### Outcome of event







#### Outcome of the event


Aim: It gives an opportunity to all members to give their ideas and opinion on a certain topic. It increases one's listening skills and confidence in speaking, and improve communication skills.







11.Technical Report writing: Careers in industry or for that matter any career calls for report writing skills. Keeping in view of the requirements of both the industry and the students, the language lab included report writing in its syllabus. In the lab the students are introduced to the basic purpose of a report: the spoken or written account of something that one has observed, heard, seen, or studied. The students are introduced to the three formal aspects of a report: preliminaries, main part and the supplementaries. The preliminaries include title page, terms of reference, contents, list of tables or diagrams, acknowledgements and summary. The main part includes the introduction, methodology, results, discussion and conclusions or recommendations. The supplementary includes the references, appendices and glossary.



**Power point presentations**: PPTs have become a part of a professional's life. Irrespective of one's profession, each one of us use PPT as tool of presentations. Thus one should know how to use such modern tools. In the language lab PPT are used to present one's ideas and thoughts to the audience. They supplement one's efforts to covey one's ideas in the form of tables, illustrations. But the students are cautioned not overuse them as complete dependence on them can defeat the very purpose of using them
