Introduction:

CMR College of Engineering & Technology (CMRCET for short) is sponsored by MGRI Educational Society, established in 2002, with concept of equal opportunities to one and all. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CENTRE (EOC), CMRCET is to ensure persons of all gender (students, staff, faculties or the community) from various diverse backgrounds are not deprived of their rightful opportunities. Purpose of the EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CENTRE (EOC) is to prepare the students list at the time of admission for SC, ST, BC, minority, PWD person and women. Department wise student list made available to faculty for communication and needy persons will approach EOC. EOC will update the same to the members for convene the meeting to address the issues raised by the students with oral/ verbal/ letter/ mail. The EOC Decision will be communicated to the departments for monitoring the action taken.

Selecting of the member for EOC is done by respective Department heads. These members will look into the various issue/ concerns of the student of that particular department. Each department, a faculty will be associated to monitor effectively. Common grievance will be addressed by EOC and the specific will be dealt by authorized persons of EOC. The performance of this Students regards academic curricular/ extracurricular will be monitored by concerned Department, periodically reviewed by EOC. EOC will organize activities like workshops/ exhibition/ interaction with experts as and when required to improve skills of the students.

Convener of EOC is supposed to release the correspondence related to the activities to be conducted for a particular academic year duly approved by the IQAC coordinator before end of previous academic year. At least 2 activities per semester or 4 activities for an academic year have to be compiled. Chairman of EOC release an office order in the month of May regarding the members of the committee for the next academic year.

Objectives

Composition

- 2. One senior faculty member to be appointed as a program Convener by the head of the Institution.
- 3. Faculty and student members from each department.

Roles and Responsibilities

1. Focusing on overall personality and skill development so as to ensure enhancing their employability.

- 2. Inclusive growth to become part of mainstream of society.
- 3. Provide personal counseling and career guidance.
- 4. Awareness building and sensitization regarding discrimination on various grounds.
- To create barrier free environment in the college campus for Persons with Disabilities for career growth.
- 6. Ensuring non-discrimination for PWD persons.

Access-Audit for Barrier Free Campus: An Access Audit of the entire campus has been carried out with a view to make academic, administrative and residential buildings and public places in the college campus accessible for wheel-chair users and the visually impaired to facilitate higher education. During the process, a plethora of issues pertaining to the required safety measures and infrastructure facilities were taken into consideration.

Steps towards creation of a Barrier Free Environment:

Though certain measures (such as putting special ramps, disabled-friendly toilets, etc.) have been taken earlier in order to facilitate persons with disabilities, there remained areas which necessitate further attention and improvement to make the college accessible for disabled persons.

.Lift:

Lift installed in various buildings of the college for facilitating the independence and mobility of the persons with disabilities. While certain measures have been taken in the past to make the lifts accessible to persons with disabilities.

Toilets:

Adequate lighting in the toilets provided in college assist the students with low vision. Construction was carried out in the toilets on the ground floors in hostels to make them more disabled-friendly, however, certain problems which are still being faced by students have been identified and efforts are underway to rectify such problems.

Wheel Chairs:

Wheelchairs (including wheelchairs with commode and folding foot) were procured by the Equal Opportunity Office during this period for students with disabilities.

Complaints Redressal Mechanism:

Equal Opportunity centre is committed to fulfilling to maintaining social harmony among various sections of the college community. Complaint Box is provided it will opened every week on Saturday. Whenever any case of social discrimination is brought before the Equal Opportunity Centre, it is thoroughly investigated and examined and suitable action is recommended. Addressing of issues related to any social discrimination faced by students or staff at any level is amongst the principal objectives of the Equal Opportunity centre.

Frequency of Meetings

Road safety awareness

A Seminar on "Road Safety for Divyangs" held at CMRCET, Hyderabad on March 23, 2015 by Professor B Prasad gave informative lectures to the students.

They informed the students that owning to the violation of traffic rules on roads by underage driving roads have become very unsafe, especially persons. They presented shocking statistics connected with road rage. According to Road Accident Statistics India 1214 road crashes occur every day in India. 20 children under the age of 14 die every day due to road crashes in the country. One serious road accident in the country occurs every minute and 16 people die on Indian roads every hour.

They made students aware of the newly passed Road Safety Juvenile Driving Laws. According to the recently implemented Road Safety Bill 2016 the guardian /owner shall be deemed to be guilty in cases of offences by the juveniles and juvenile shall be tried under JJ act. The representatives from the Traffic Police Ludhiana appealed to the students to follow traffic rules to maintain safety for one and all.

The students enjoyed the interactive session with professor Prasad and were inspired to take the message back home about how critical road safety is. They were given the responsibility of ensuring that their family members follow the rules of the road, as breaking rules might be dangerous or fatal. Professor B Prasad explained the risks of wheeling on the roads. He requested underage students not to drive vehicles on the road and to be civic conscious citizens.

Principal Dr M RamaligaReddy and professor Prasad flagged off the safety walk at which teachers, college bus drivers, cleaners and other support staffs were present. The students walked till the kandlakoya area and spread awareness by holding placards with messages of safety on the roads while driving and walking, shouted slogans and distributed pamphlets. The policemen who were on duty on Medchal Road, assisted in the smooth movement of traffic and safety of the students on the walk.

Venkat and Ramani students participated in the walk rallie and explained to traveler's about and wearing helmets.





Benefits of Road Safety Barriers

Roads and highways should be designed and constructed in a way that ensures and guarantees safe, effective, convenient and efficient transportation of people and different kinds of goods or materials. It is always recommended and it is expected for drivers to travel at speeds which are appropriate to the conditions of the roads in order to reach their final destination in a safe manner. Still, car accidents and crashes are common unwanted events. Every year the number of car crashes and accidents in Telangana state.

There are many reasons why car accidents happen on the roads, such as:

- Driver's driving habits or error
- Driving over speed limits
- Driver's fatigue
- Alcohol or drug consummation
- Mechanical failure of the vehicle
- Tough weather conditions such as rain, snow, wind etc.

When drivers loose control over their vehicles, there are high risks of collisions and impacts with other vehicles or objects near the road. Therefore, the roads and highways need to be constructed and designed with safety road barriers. Road safety barriers are described as vehicle protection systems which are specially designed to protect the vehicles on the roads, to save many lives and to be maintenance free for at least 30-50 years.

Outcomes

- 1. It recognises that prevention effortsnot with standing, road users will remain fallible and crashes will occur.
- 2. It stresses that those involved in the design of the road transport system need to accept and share responsibility for the safety of the system, and those that use the system need to accept responsibility for complying with the rules and constraints of the system.
