A Report on “One Day Seminar on Employability Skills for Engineering Students”





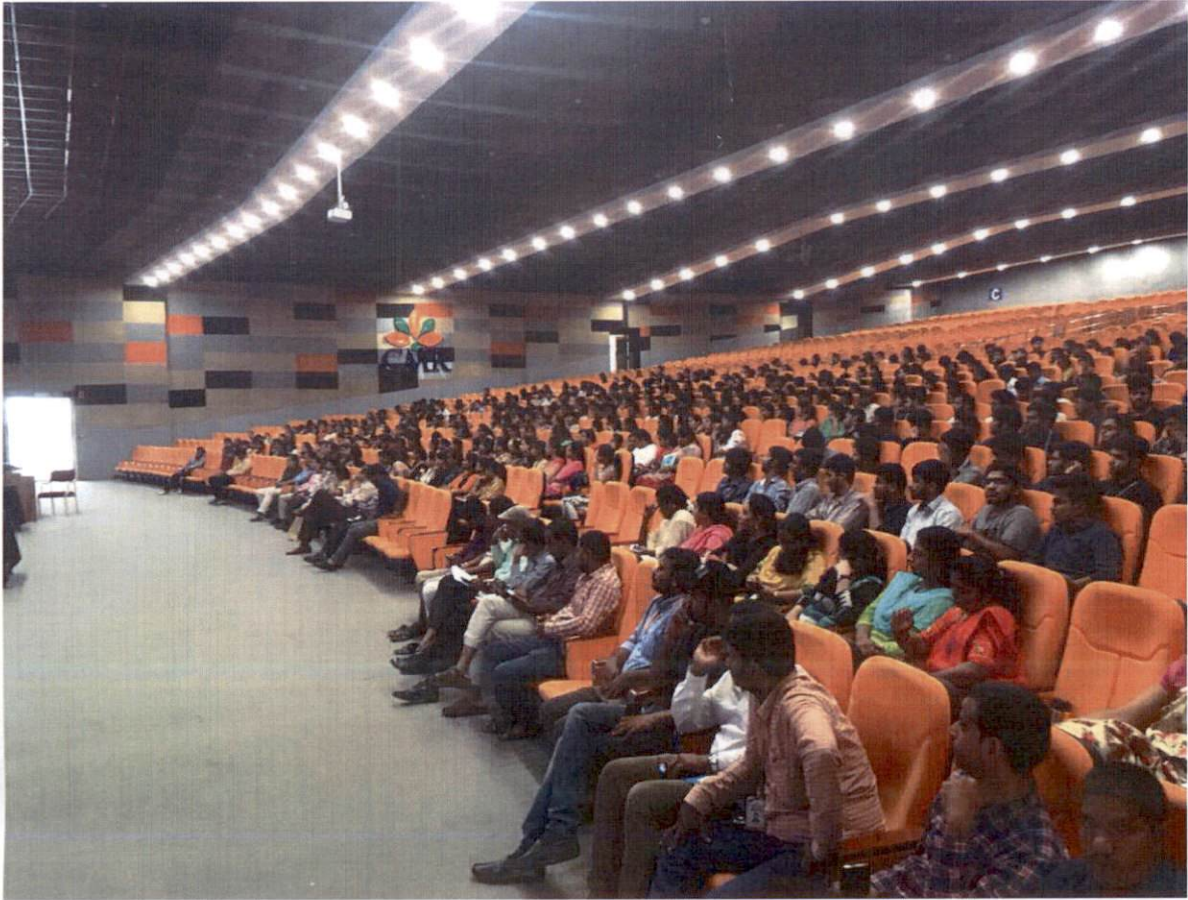

These include a National Road Safety Policy, which outlines various policy measures such as promoting awareness, establishing road safety information database, encouraging safer road infrastructure and applying intelligent transport, and enforcement of safety laws.

It is always recommended and it is expected for drivers to travel at speeds which are appropriate to the conditions of the roads in order to reach their final destination in a safe manner. Still, car accidents and crashes are common unwanted events. Every year the number of car crashes and accidents in Telangana State.



Road safety barriers are described as vehicle protection systems which are specially designed to protect the vehicles on the roads, to save many lives and to be maintenance free for at least 30-50 years.

Outcomes




