authority in the government, realize the need and significance of NSS. The motto of the NSS is "**NOT ME BUT YOU**". This word is the essence of democratic living and upholds the

need for selfless service and appreciation of others. The symbol of the NSS is designed based on 'Rath wheel' of Konark, the Sun Temple of Orissa. The wheel signifies the progressive cycle of life. The symbol of NSS Badge contains 24 wheels in the Rath of the Sun Temple of Konark. Each Wheel has eight bars which represents 8 pahars of day. The red colour in the badge indicates that the NSS volunteers are full of blood, i.e. lively, active and spirited. The navy blue color indicates the cosmos of which the NSS is a tiny part ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind.

OBJECTIVES:

- The main objective of the NSS is to instill the idea of social welfare in students and provide community services without bias.
- Every volunteer works to ensure that who is the actual needy to get help for their living which promotes living standards.




Report on Massive Bucket Immersion:


