Thus, preferential treatment for the depressed classes (SCs and STs), should not be understood as an act of magnanimity on the part of the political elite at the national level but rather a strategy to give them a share in power in politics and administration and to uplift them socially and economically . In my research paper I just explained the condition of schedule caste and schedule tribe and what are provisions available to them under the constitution of India. These provisions are just like a helping hand for them to improve their condition. When all the sections of people developed then only our country will become a developed country. The introductory remarks were made by the IQAC Coordinator of the college, Devadas and all the HODs and faculty members were participated of this seminar. Dr. P.
