This is with reference to the proposal submitted by CMR College of Engineering & Technology, Kandlakoya (V), Hyderabad, affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Hyderabad, for extension of autonomous status.

The Commission, in its meeting held on 24.06.2025, has approved the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Autonomous Colleges to extend the autonomous status to CMR College of Engineering & Technology, Kandlakoya (V), Medchal Road, Hyderabad-501401, affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Hyderabad, for a period of 10 years from the academic year 2025-2026 to 2034-2035, as per clause 8.2 of UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023.

The University is, therefore, requested to issue the necessary notification within 30 days regarding the extension of autonomous status to the College as per the above-mentioned UGC Regulations. The autonomous college is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges, 2023. The Regulations are available on [www.ugc.gov.in](http://www.ugc.gov.in). Non-compliance with the requirements and conditions prescribed in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -13 of the UGC Regulations, 2023. The college shall apply to the University Grants Commission for an extension of autonomous status at least three months before the completion of the period of autonomy.

The College shall apply for the required NAAC/NBA accreditation at least six months before the expiry of the current validity and obtain the NAAC/NBA grading as per the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023 and intimate the same to UGC.
  - b. The College shall upload a report on its website regarding the Examination Cell and constitution of Statutory Bodies as required under Clauses 11 and 12 of the UGC Regulations of Autonomous Colleges, 2023, to ensure proper management of academic, financial, and general administrative affairs.
  - c. The College is advised to take the necessary steps for the implementation of NEP 2020 and upload the same on the UGC UTSAH Portal.
  - d. The Autonomous Colleges shall at all times adhere to UGC Regulations and Guidelines made and issued by the Commission from time to time, failing which UGC may take appropriate action against the defaulting Autonomous College, including revoking of autonomous status as per Clause -13.1 of the UGC Regulations, 2023.

This has reference to the proposal submitted by CMR College of Engineering & Technology, Kandlakoya, medchal Road, Hyderabad – 501401 Telangana affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad, Telangana for extension of autonomous status under the UGC Scheme for Autonomous Colleges.

As per the decision of the Standing Committee constituted by University Grants Commission, in its meeting held on 11.02.2021, the Competent Authority has decided to extend the autonomous status to **CMR College of Engineering & Technology, Kandlakoya, medchal Road, Hyderabad-501401 Telangana** affiliated to **Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad, Telangana** for a period of Five (05) years from the session 2020-2021 to 2024-2025, as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.5 of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018.

The University is requested to issue necessary notification/order regarding extension of autonomous status to the College as per the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018 for Autonomous Colleges. The College, if eligible, shall apply for autonomy grant as per the norms laid down in the Regulations.

The Autonomous College is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The Regulations are available on the UGC website, [www.ugu.ac.in](http://www.ugu.ac.in). Non compliance of the requirements and conditions in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -14 of the UGC Regulations – 2018. Further, it may be noted that the above said college shall also apply in the prescribed format to University Grants Commission for extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.

Further, your attention is invited to the clause 6.3 of UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018 as given below:




"The colleges must be accredited by either NAAC with minimum 'A' Grade or by NBA for at least three programme(s) with a minimum score of 675 individually or a corresponding accreditation Grade/score from a UGC empanelled accreditation agency. However, if the number of programme(s) being run by the Institution is less than three, then each of the programmes should secure 675 or more marks. Accreditation status must be valid at the time of application.

Provided further, the existing autonomous colleges will be required to comply with this eligibility condition by 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 as per Clause of 6.3 of UGC, Regulations 2018.

The college is requested to take necessary action accordingly.

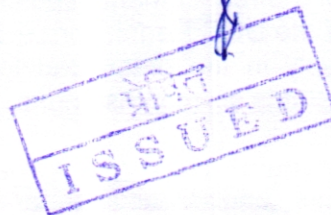
