


Lab activities and events:

English lab provides opportunities for the students to practice and tune their language skills. Both the English lab manual and the language software provided by **K-VAN Solutions** integrate the following activities that are aimed at enriching English language fluency of the learners. While some activities are practiced in ELCS lab, the other activities are meant for AECS lab where students are trained in activities that are very practical in nature in terms of preparing students for life after academics.



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
1. JAM: 'Just a Minute' is an impromptu speech test conducted with the time limit of one minute. The students are trained to speak coherently and meaningfully on a given topic within a span of one minute. More than a test of knowledge, JAM can be seen as a test of wit and presence of mind. Many recruitment drives use this test to assess a candidate's language skills. The teacher encourages the students to participate in JAM sessions in order to improve their language fluency and accuracy. Before the session the teacher prepares a list of topics which are then randomly given to each student to speak. The students are advised not to hesitate when they speak. They are also told not to repeat and deviate from the topic.




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
2. Role Play: Role Play is speaking activity where one either puts oneself into somebody else's shoes or one may put oneself in an imaginary situation. Thus the learners can themselves to be the president or the prime minister of a country. They then can enact the role using appropriate language. Such activities make learning enjoyable and interesting. Enacting imaginary situations allow the students to practice language needed for such situations. Situations such as checking in at hotel, requesting for directions help the learners to understand the practical nature of language. Students who find participating in conversations and dialogues uncomfortable can use role play as a means to express themselves with good communication.






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
3.Group discussions: Group Discussions have become a part of recruitment processes where the representatives of the recruiting organization observes the communication skills and other interpersonal skills of the participants before short listing them for the next round. CMRCET has an exclusive room with round tables for group discussions. The students are given various topics for the discussions. Their performance is observed by the teacher and a feedback is given. The students are told about the importance of taking initiative in a group discussion. They are also explained about the importance of listening to others so that they can intervene at the right time. The language software allows the student to observe the videos of sample discussions and improve their performances.




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
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4. Interview Skills: For students of professional courses like engineering the biggest challenge is to succeed at the interviews. The lab activities help the students to understand the necessary preparation for any interview. The students are introduced the ideas of pre-interview planning and preparation. They are also taught the need to understand the job profile before actually attending the interview. The students are also taught to prepare well for the interview by brushing up the basics. The teacher conducts mock interviews for the students to expose them to interview like situations.





- 3. Non Violence


64 enthusiastic participants registered for the event and all the students gave their best performance. The winners of the competition are:




6.Resume writing: Preparing one's resume is one of the most important of any student's transition from college to career. While understanding the structure of resume is important, what goes into making a good resume is even more important. In the lab the students are taught how to structure their resume in terms of their career objective, profile, achievements and skills. They are also taught to keep their resume brief. Most importantly the students are encouraged to participate in various cultural and technical events which find their way into their resume. It is because mere academic qualifications will not fetch them a job.





7.Technical Report writing: Careers in industry or for that matter any career calls for report writing skills. Keeping in view of the requirements of both the industry and the students, the language lab included report writing in its syllabus. In the lab the students are introduced to the basic purpose of a report: the spoken or written account of something that one has observed, heard, seen, or studied. The students are introduced to the three formal aspects of a report: preliminaries, main part and the supplementaries. The preliminaries include title page, terms of reference, contents, list of tables or diagrams, acknowledgements and summary. The main part includes the introduction, methodology, results, discussion and conclusions or recommendations. The supplementary includes the references, appendices and glossary.




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
8. PPT Presentation:

Language lab Annual Report

CMRCET has separate language laboratories for the first and third year students of all branches of B.Tech. The language labs complement the classroom learning which is explanatory in nature. Hence the language labs provide opportunities to learners to put into practice their skills. We are using **K-Van Solutions** software in the labs. While the first year language laboratory is known as English Language Communications Skills Lab (ELCS), the lab for the third years is known as Advanced Communication Skills Lab (AECS). The first year students are introduced to English sound system and pronunciation. They are also trained in listening and speaking activities. The third year students are introduced to more advanced skills such as resume writing, interview skills, presentation skills, group discussion in view of the necessity of acquiring employability skills. The labs are equipped with language software and multimedia computers apart from projectors for classroom use.

Class work for the first year students of B.Tech students for the academic year 2021-22 started on 06th December 2021. After the mandatory induction program the class work commenced on 06th December 2021. During the Lab Sessions the students were trained in various aspects of language such as Conversation Skills, Role Play, Vocabulary, Resume preparation, Presentation skills, Group Discussion and Interview skills.

Ms.G.Laxmi, Ms.G.Vasantha, Ms.E.Madhavi, Ms.RosyMatilda, Ms.S.Swapna, and Ms.N.Sameera were the teacher-facilitators for the ELCS and AECS sessions. The students actively participated in these sessions as the activities have a direct bearing on the campus recruitment process which begins in the fourth of their study. The classroom facilities such as internet enabled computers and projectors along with the audio system were effectively used to present the concepts and train the students. The group discussions were conducted in the adjoining room which is specially meant for the training purposes.

Gap Analysis

The language lab committee reviewed both the programs conducted and the performance of the students for the academic year (2021-22). It appreciated the contribution of the faculty and the students to make the language lab sessions fruitful and effective. The committee went into the every detail of the language lab. It interacted with the teachers and the lab in-charges. The committee found that classes were of heterogeneous in nature. As a result some students were able to participate in various activities conducted in the lab. But many of the learners were also hesitant to speak in the lab due to various cultural and social factors. Thus there is a gap between what the course aims to achieve in terms of its objectives and the abilities of the learners to make use of the laboratory situations to improve their communication skills. The committee, upon close examination found that students who come from urban areas are able to communicate better and display no anxiety when asked to speak in the class/lab. The committee decided to form groups where students who are good at expressing themselves and whose English skills are good work with students who are from rural areas so that they overcome their inhibitions to speak and communicate in the lab.
