
REPORT ON SEMINAR ON CYBERCRIME AND LEGAL FRAMEWORK

The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) of CMR College of Engineering & Technology organized a seminar on "Cybercrime and Legal Framework" on 14th December 2024. The session was conducted by Smt. P. Anitha, Sub-Inspector, Police Station, Medchal, to educate students and faculty about various cyber threats, legal provisions, and preventive measures against cybercrimes. The seminar aimed to raise awareness on online safety, legal rights, and best practices for digital security. Smt. Anitha explained different cyber threats, including hacking, cyberbullying, financial frauds, and social media crimes. Real-life case studies were shared to illustrate the impact of cybercrimes. The speaker elaborated on various legal sections applicable to cybercrimes and the process of filing a complaint with the cyber police. The participants were informed about the Cyber Crime Helpline (1930) and the National Cybercrime Reporting Portal (www.cybercrime.gov.in).

Following Preventive Measures are discussed: Importance of strong passwords, multi-factor authentication (MFA), and social media privacy settings, Awareness about phishing emails, fake job offers, and online scams, Best practices for safe browsing and secure financial transactions.

The seminar concluded with an **interactive session**, where students and faculty members asked questions regarding **cybersecurity threats and legal recourse**. Smt. P. Anitha addressed common concerns and provided **practical tips to stay safe online**.

- A special tribute was paid to women faculty and staff for their dedication and excellence in academics and administration.


