TGEAPCET-2026: FAQs DURING THE ADMISSION PROCESS

1. Can I get admission to an allocated college if I don't pay the fee through the TGEAPCET website student login before the date mentioned in allotment order?

No. Your admission will be automatically cancelled if you do not pay the fee through the TGEAPCET website on or before the date mentioned by the TGEAPCET Convener in the allotment order.

2. What is the last date for payment of fee for the first phase allotment.

According to the notification given by the TGEAPCET-2026, the last date for paying the fee and generating the Joining Report is 14.07.2026. However, we advise you to keep checking the <https://tgeapcet.nic.in/> for updates.

3. Can I get admission to this college if I pay the fee but don't generate the Joining Report through the TGEAPCET website?

No. Even if you pay the applicable fee, your admission will be automatically cancelled if you do not generate the Joining Report through the website <https://tgeapcet.nic.in/>.

4. I got admission to college in the first phase but didn't pay the fee. Can I participate in the second-phase counselling?

Yes. You can participate in the second-phase counselling even if you didn't pay the fee for the college allotted in the first phase. **However, you will lose any claim over the first-phase allotted seat. It will be automatically cancelled.**

5. I paid the fee and generated the Joining Report for the seat allocated in the first-phase college. I participated in the second-phase counselling, but no seat was allocated. Does my admission in the first-phase college remain valid?

Yes. Even if you participate in the second-phase counselling, if no seat is allocated in the second-phase, your seat from the first phase will remain valid provided you have paid the fee and generated the Joining Report on or before the date mentioned in the allotment order of first phase.

6. I paid the fee and generated the Joining Report for the seat allocated in the first-phase college. I participated in the second-phase counselling, and a seat was allocated in a different college/branch. If I don't like the second-phase allocation, does my admission in the first-phase college/branch remain valid?

No. Once a new college/branch is allocated in the second-phase, you lose your claim on the first-phase allotted seat.

7. I got a seat in this college in the second-phase, but the fee I paid for the first-phase college is more than this college's fee. Will the college refund the difference?

No. The differential fee will be refunded by the TGEAPCET Convener to the account/card through which you paid the fee after the admission process is completed. The college has no role in this regard.

8. I got a seat in XYZ branch in ABC College, and I'm satisfied with my allocation. Do I still need to give options in the second-phase?

Not required. If you are satisfied with the current seat allocation, you do not need to give options in the SECOND/FINAL PHASE counselling. However, it is mandatory to:

a) Pay the fee and generate the Joining Report on or before the date mentioned in the allotment order.

b) Report to the college allotted with all the relevant documents on or before the date mentioned in the allotment order of second-phase counselling.

9. I got a seat in a particular college in second-phase. I paid the fee and generated the Joining Report before the deadline. However, due to unavoidable reasons, I could not report to the college on time. Can I get an extension to report, since I have already paid the fee?

No. Even if you have paid the fee on time and generated the Joining Report, your seat will be automatically cancelled if you fail to report to the college on or before the date mentioned by the Convener.

10. How much refund will I get if I cancel the admission after a particular phase?

The college has no role in the refund process. Please check the instructions provided by the TGEAPCET Convener on the website <https://tgeapcet.nic.in/> and in the allotment order.

11. What is the last date to report to the allotted college?

As per the notification of TGEAPCET-2026, as of now the last date to pay the fee for the second-phase allotted seat is 24.07.2026 and last date to report to the college in person with relevant documents is 28.07.2026. However, please check the website <https://tgeapcet.nic.in/> regularly for any updates.

12. Which certificates do I need to produce while reporting to the college?

You need to produce all the relevant original certificates along with two sets of photocopies. Please keep two sets of photocopies with you for future reference. Also, scan all the original documents and email them to yourself along with downloaded rank card, allotment order (latest) and Joining Report (latest). Please check the college website for the complete list of CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED DURING JOINING.

13. I got admission in the first/second-phase of counselling, but I am not satisfied with the allotment, so I did not pay the fee or generate the Joining Report. Am I eligible to participate in the FINAL PHASE counselling?

NO. Only those candidates who paid the fee, generated the Joining Report, **and** reported at the allotted college on or before the date mentioned in the allotment order **are** eligible to participate in the FINAL PHASE counselling.

14. I got admission in the first/second-phase of counselling. I have paid the fee and generated the Joining Report. However, due to unavoidable reasons, I could not report physically to the allotted college before the date mentioned in the allotment order. Am I eligible to participate in the FINAL PHASE counselling?

No. Just paying the fee and generating the Joining Report is not enough. You must report to the college in person before the last date mentioned in the allotment order. If you didn't report to the college on time, you cannot attend the final phase counselling. Also, your allotted seat will be cancelled automatically.

15. I got a seat in some branch in the college. Can I change into another branch in the same college?

No, the college authorities have no role in changing the branch. However, you can apply for the **internal sliding through the site** <https://tgeapcet.nic.in/>. According to the notification given by the TGEAPCET-2026, as of now the dates for internal sliding on the website are **12/08/2026 to 13/08/2026**. However, we advise you to keep checking the website for updates.

16. During the second-phase/third phase, I paid the fee, generated the Joining Report and reported in the college by producing required documents. However, now I don't want to continue. Can the seat be cancelled at the college end?

No. Once you report to the college, your TC will not be given back unless you get the seat cancellation letter signed with official stamp by the Convener, TGEAPCET-2026

17. I got a seat in a college, but I don't have a Debit card/ Credit card/ Net banking. Can I pay the cash in the college?

No. The cash will not be accepted in the college. It is your responsibility to find some close friend/ relative to you to pay in fee online through student login. The college has no role in this entire process.

18. Can I pay the fee through any Mee Seva Person's Account/ Internet Café person's account by paying the cash to him?

You are advised not to do it because any kind of refund by the convener will be debited only to the person from which account/card the fee was paid.

19. For example, college fee where I was allocated is Rs 1,25,000/- but I have two cards with each limit of 1,00,000/- each. Can I pay Rs 1,00,000/- from one card and the remaining 25,000/- from another card?

No. This is not possible. You cannot pay the fee from more than one card/ account.

20. What is the date of commencement of classwork?

Please keep checking the college website for updates.

21. What is the transport fee for the college?

The transportation fee is

- ₹49,000/- from any point in Hyderabad and
- ₹54,000/- for the buses coming through ORR

22. What is the hostel fee for the college?

The hostel fee is ₹1,15,000/- for the current academic year.

23. Can we pay the hostel fee in instalments?

Yes:

- 1st Instalment: ₹65,000/- at the time of joining
- 2nd Instalment: ₹50,000/- on or before 30/09/2026
